

How subjects work in the junior school

Year 7

In Year 7 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Technology, Social Studies, Music and PE and Health throughout the year.

They will also take **half a year each** of Te Reo Maori and Japanese and **one term each** of Drama, Dance, Art and Music.

For their subject classes students are placed in a core class which will be different from their Whanau class. Core classes may change from year to year whereas students will stay in the same Whanau class for pastoral care, from Year 7 to Year 13.

Year 8

In Year 8 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Technology, Social Studies and PE and Health throughout the year.

They will also take **half a year each** of Te Reo Maori and French and **one term each** of Drama, Dance, Art and Music.

Year 9

In Year 9 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Technology, Social Studies and PE and Health throughout the year.

They will also take a language of their choice (numbers permitting) **for the year** and **one term each** of Drama, Dance, Art and Music.

Year 10

In Year 10 students all take Religious Education (R.E.), English, Maths, Science, Social Studies and PE and Health throughout the year plus three option including technologies, arts and languages.
